by virtue of Certificate No 13 dated the 11th day of July 1807 issued by the Board of
KNOW YE, That in consideration of an Entry made in the Entry Taker's Office of
Commissioners for West Tennessee to Walter Browley and entered on
County, the 15th day of September 1807, by No 489 pursuant to the provisions of an
Act of the General Assembly, passed by the State of Tennessee on the _____ day of _____ 18_____

THERE IS GRANTED by the said State of Tennessee unto the said Walter Browley and
his heirs

a certain Tract or Parcel of Land, containing Two Thousand nine hundred and fifty acres by Survey,
bearing date the _____ day of _____ 18_____, lying in ^{Warren} said County.

In the 2^d ^{fractional} District T05 & range No 9.

Beginning at a Dogwood the N.E. Corner of 1^d
Fractional Section T05 & runs thence west with the line
of fractional Section No 6. Six hundred paces to a Black
oak by a Black oak in said Section line. thence South 787
Paces to a Spanish oak on the Cumberland Mountain. thence
East 600 paces to an ash in the eastern boundary of 2^d
district. thence along said North 787 paces to the beginning
Surveyed the 28 of Octr 1808 by Patrick McCalla Heam

With the Hereditaments and Appurtenances. To have and to hold the said Tract or Parcel of Land, with its Appurtenances, to the said Walter Browley, and his heirs forever.
