STATE OF TENNESSEE--No. 16700

To all to whom these presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That, for and in consideration of the sum of twelve and one half cents per acre, paid into the office of the Entry-Taker of Warren County, and entered on the Sixth day of April 1824 pursuant to the provisions of an Act of the General Assembly of said state, passed on the twentysecond day of November, one thousand eight hundred and twentythree, and the Acts supplemental thereto, by No. 23

there is granted by the said State of Tennessee, unto William Thomas a certain Tract or Parcel of LAND, containing sixteen acres by survey bearing date the twelfth day of May 1824 lying in said county, on the head

Waters of Hickory Creek in what is called Hubbards Cove adjoining a twenty acre tract that said Thomas lives on and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a large stone the north west corner of said twenty acre tract at the foot of Cumberland Mountain Running East with said line Eighty poles to a Chestnut in the west boundary of Joseph Wagnons tract whereon he now lives Thence North with said line four and three fourth poles to a Beech at the foot of the mountain Thence South fifty one degrees West one hundred and three poles to the Beginning Inclusive of said Thomas improvement

With the hereditaments and appurtenances. To Have and to Hold the said William Thomas

the said Tract or Parcel of LAND, with its appurtenances, to and his heirs forever.

In Witness Whereof, William Carroll Governor of the State of Tennessee, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed, at Nashville, on the fourth day of September in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and twentyseven, and of the

independence of the United States, the fiftysecond.
