This indenture made this 3<sup>d</sup> of October  
in the year of Our Lord one Thousand  
Eight hundred and thirty Seven by and  
between John Winton of the County of Ceffe  
and State of Virginia of the one part and  
William Lusk of the County of Ceffe and  
State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth  
that for an amercement of the Sum of  
fifty Dollars to him in hand well and truly paid  
the Receipt is hereby acknowledged hath bargain  
ed granted sold and by these presents doth grant  
bargain and sell unto the said William Lusk  
his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of  
Land Situated lying and being in the County and  
State aforesaid on the waters of Hickory Creek  
beginning on an ash at or near William  
Thomes northeast corner Running South fifty  
poles to a Sycamore and pointing South fifty  
twenty poles to a clematis tree and pointing  
at the bluff of Cumberland mountain thence  
north twelve poles to a Hickory and pointing thence  
East twenty four poles to a white Oak on the  
bluff thence north thirty eight poles to a Stake  
at or near the South Boundary of said Thomas  
or John Winton thence West forty four poles to the  
beginning by Estimation containing all Acres  
of Land with all and singular the hereditaments  
and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any  
wise appertaining and all the Estate right title  
interest claim and demand whatsoever of him  
the said John Winton of in and to the said Lands  
and premises and Every part and parcel thereof  
to have and to hold the said Land and premises  
above mentioned and Every part or parcel thereof  
with the appurtenances unto the said William Lusk

his heirs and assigns to the Only proper use and  
 behoof of the said William Dusk his heirs and  
 assigns forever and the said John Uentor for  
 himself and his heirs and all and Every other  
 person whatever civil account and for Ever defend  
 to the said William Dusk his heirs and assigns  
 in Court or otherwise of the said John Uentor has  
 here unto set his hand and seal the date above  
 written
