This indenture made this 27th of Octobr in the
year of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred
and thirty seven by and between William
Clemens of the County of Coffee and State of
Tennessee of the one part and William
Surr of the County of Coffee and State of said
Tennessee that the said William Clemens
for an consideration of the sum of five dollars
to him in hand well and truly paid the Receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted
conveyed and sold and do by these presents
both Grant bargain and sell unto the said
William Surr his heirs and assigns a certain tract
or parcel of land situated lying and being in
the County of Coffee on the waters of Hickory Creek
Beginning at a white Oak standing eight
poles north of a cave spring and running
East thirty five poles to a hickory three
South Eighteen and one third poles to a dogwood
thence West thirty five poles to an ash and
Sugartree three north Eighteen and two third
poles to the Beginning by Estimation containing
4 acres of land with all and singular
the hereditaments Appurtenances thereunto
belonging Or in anywise appertaining and
all the Estate right title interest claims and
demands what ever of them the said William
Clemens of in and to the said Surr and
heirs and Every part and parcel thereof
to have and to hold the said land
premises above mentioned and Every part
and parcel thereof with the Appurtenances
unto the said William Surr his heirs and
assigns to the Only proper use and behoof
of the said William Surr his heirs and
