

DANIEL CONRY

Dan Conry from Cork Co. Ireland came to the United States about 1850, or maybe a few years earlier. It was during the potato famine, and like many others, he was facing starvation in Ireland. It is believed by some a sister came to New York at the same time.

From New York he came to Tennessee working from job to job at railroad building, especially bridges, as he was a mason. In Tennessee he worked on the Capital, at building the tunnel between Cowan and Bridgeport and the coke ovens at Tracy City. He bought a farm in Pelham valley.

Dan Conry and Frances Keeling were married April 9, 1855 by Rev. Jonathan Jacquet, Catholic priest at Winchester.

They had twelve children. Ten were raised to adulthood. We have been able to find most of the children's baptismal records.

Dan Conry has been described to me as a hard working, mild tempered man. He was independent to the degree of wanting to provide for his family without help. Even when his house burned and neighbors suggested making up money for him, he declined saying "they would be fine and didn't need help." He loved his children and grandchildren. It is said his wife had to correct the children if they were corrected.

He had his Christmas dinner Christmas Eve, and was sure each

child at that time had all the candy he wanted. The rest of Christmas someone else could plan--if they had one. It is said his favorite supper was mush with molasses and milk.

His wife died in 1875 leaving him with ten children, the oldest nineteen and the youngest two. He died in 1894.

I JAMES CONRY

James Conry (Jim) the oldest son of Dan and Frances Conry was born January 12, 1856.

He was a miner during his younger manhood but later bought his father's homeplace and farmed the rest of his life. He had ten children, eight of whom lived to adulthood. Uncle Jim's oldest son, Mike, and his son-in-law, Ernest Willis served in World War I. His youngest son, Buford, and also four grandsons, Edgar Gunn, Jamie Goodman, Mike Emmette, and Ralph Goodman served in World War II, and a grandson, Buford Jr., in Vietnam.

Two of his older daughters lived in Okla. and I do not know much about their families, only their children's names. Jessie is a very good artist.

It is said of Uncle Jim if he gave his word you did not need any other security for he did what he promised.

II MICHAEL CONRY

Michael Conry born in 1858 was the second son of Dan and Frances Conry. He was married twice. He married sisters. He lived on the Allen White farm for a while, and his first son was born there. They named the child Daniel Edmond after his grandfather and his youngest uncle. I have heard my father, Edd Conry, tell how proud he was to run through the bottom and across the river to Uncle Mike's to take the baby a silver dollar Grandpa had given him for it. Uncle Mike soon moved to Tracy City and was overseer of the Coke Ovens there until his death at the age of forty-five.

There were seven children in his family, but two died in early childhood.

Two of his sons served in the armed forces in World War I. Both of them also worked their way through college and became professors. His youngest daughter and a granddaughter also taught school.

Frances Irene married but had no children. Belle never married.

X EDD CONRY

Edd Conry was the tenth child in The Dan Conry family. Although two children were born later, neither lived and he was always considered the baby. As his mother died before his third birthday, he was probably spoiled! He was a farmer almost all his life and never lived more than five or six miles from the place where he was born. One brother and one sister with small children lived for a time in their father's home before Papa (Edd) was married and he loved the children--hid them if their father or mother scolded them or threatened to spank them, and the children adored him. Betty Smith called him Eddie as long as he lived.

He had four children and six grandchildren. His only son, Billy Henson, served in World War II, as did his grandson, Billy Abbott Carden.

Two of his daughters taught school and his son became an airplane engineer. His oldest daughter, Gladys, was an invalid for many years, and was noted for her patience and uncomplaining disposition.

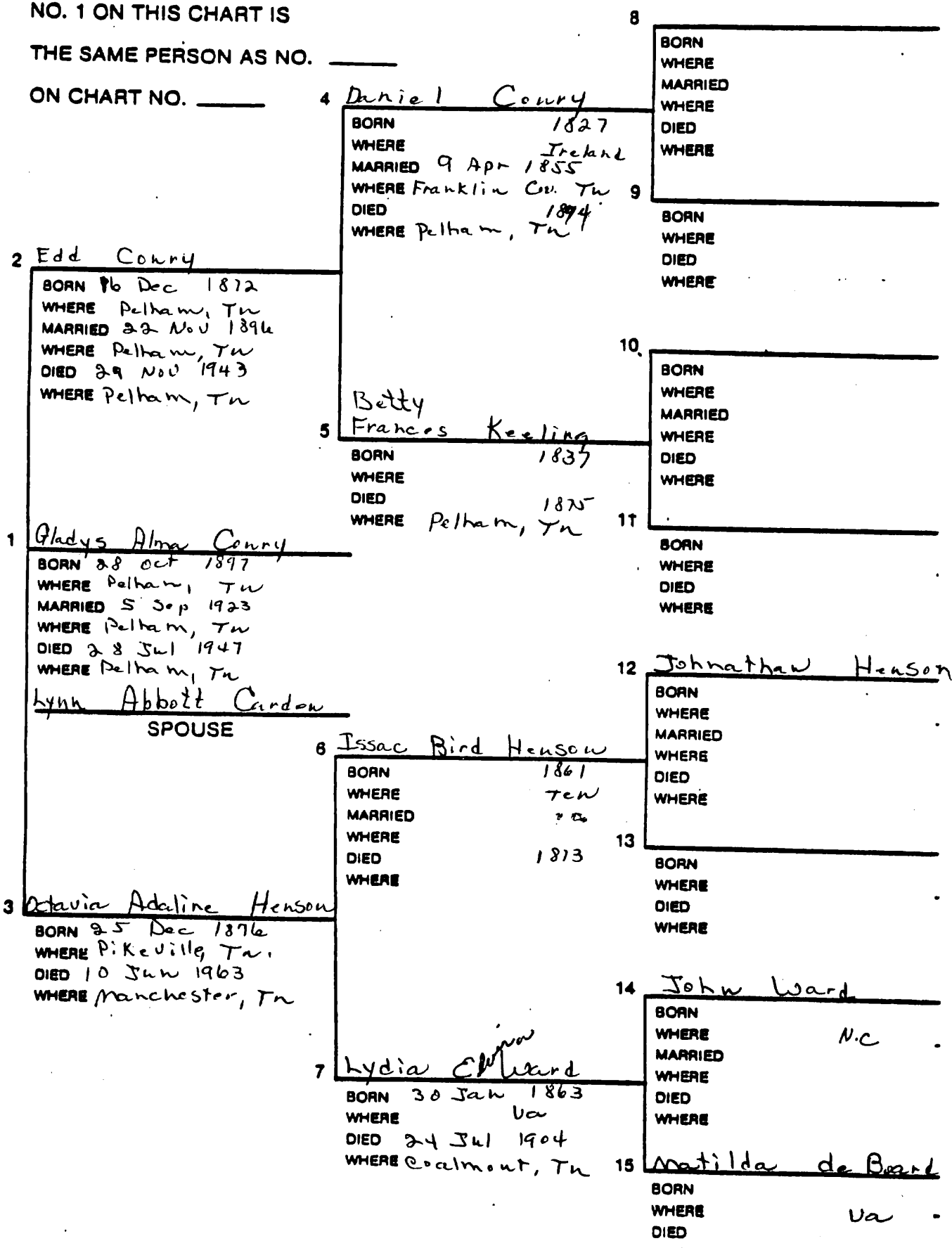
