Killian and Mary Elizabeth Dykes. *According to her Social Security Death Index, her year of death was 1968 but it is listed as 1967 on her grave marker. Her obituary listed her as being 102 years old at her time of death. Susie's obituary was published in the Chattanooga, Hamilton, Tennessee newspaper in 1968.

COALMONT, Tenn. - Mrs. Susan Creighton, perhaps Grundy County's oldest citizen, died at the home of a daughter here Friday at the age of 102.

A lifelong member of the Coalmont Methodist Church, she was the widow of William Creighton.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Arthur Roy Curtis of Coalmont and Mrs. Pauline Alexander of Chattanooga; two sons, Robert A. Creighton, Coalmont and Paul A. Creighton, South Gate, Mich.; 12 grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren. Funeral services will be held at 2pm Sunday at the Coalmont Methodist Church. Burial in Coalmont Cemetery. Active pallbearers will be grandsons and Jim Northcutt.

MCMINNVILLE, Tenn., Aug. 7 - John H.M. Creighton, 78, native of Hamilton County and well known citizen of Grundy County, died at his residence, in Palmer this morning, having following a month's illness.

A son of the late James and Polly Anne Morton Creighton, he was born in Hamilton County, Jan. 8, 1863. Besides his wife, Mrs. Mary Tate Creighton, he is survived by five sons, John H.M. Creighton, Jr., and Curg Creighton, of Palmer; Joe Creighton of Chattanooga, Morgan Creighton of Tarlton, and Frank Creighton of Beersheba Springs; four daughters, Miss Louise Creighton, Mrs. M.C. Hampton, Mrs. W.M. Brown and Mrs. ?B. Mitchell, all of Palmer; and one brother, W.M. Creighton, of Coalmont.

Funeral services to be conducted by the Rev. S.H. Elliott, of Estill Springs, will be held at the residence at 2 o'clock tomorrow afternoon. Burial will be in Fall Creek Cemetery in Grundy County.
