of which shall be on the Court house door, the biddings to be opened at six hundred dollars, twenty-five of which to be paid down and the purchaser to give bond and security for the residue payable twelve months after date, and a lien retained upon the negro slave until the purchase money is fully paid, and it is further ordered that petitioner have until the next term of this court to enter into bond with security as the law directs and that said petitioner proceed not to sell said slave until he enter into bond as aforesaid.

This day John Tipton Sheriff of Grundy County admitted Richard E. Stepp his deputy. Whereupon the Said Stepp came into Court and took the oaths prescribed by law for deputy Sheriffs and was thereupon admitted to exercise the functions of his office.

This day Carter Scruggs the Entry taker elect of Grundy County come into open court and entered into Bond together with Richard Bradford, John Hobbs, John Northcut, William Armstrong, John Fults, John Burrows and A. M. Stepp as his security Conditioned as the law directs. Whereupon the said Scruggs took the oath prescribed by law for entry taker and was thereupon admitted to exercise the functions of his office.

P-243 Ordered by the Court that Albert Campbell commonly called Bird Campbell's precinct as overseer of the road be extended to the Corporate limits of the Town of Altamont.

Ordered by the Court that William Armstrong have Henderson Kid in addition to the hands that he now has to work and keep in repair the road of which he is overseer.

Ordered by the Court that James Lairs be appointed overseer of a second class road in the room and stead of James M. Nunley and have the same bounds, and hands and keep the same in repair and in addition to his present hands he also have William R. Nunley attached to his list.

Ordered by the Court that an order made to Wm. R. Nunley as overseer of the road in the year 1847 in the room of Richard Bradford be recinded and it is further ordered that L. D. Tucker be appointed overseer of the road beginning near the top of the mountain at the forks of the road leading into Burrows Cove, running by Richard Bradfords,

thence to intersect the old Turnpike road near Jerry Nunleys and have the following hands (vis,) Wm. Goens, Vincent Gibbs, Charles B. Ellis, Robert Kilgore and keep the same in repair.

Court then adjourned until Court in Course.

#### P-244 State of Tennessee

Be it remembered that at a county court begun and held for the County of Grundy at the courthouse in the Town of Altamont, on the first Monday being the seventh day of June, A. D. 1852, and the 76th year of the Independence of the United States. Present the worshipful Carter Scruggs, Chairman, Richard Bradford and Adrian Northcutt, Justices of the quorum, &c.

Ordered by the Court that Noalz Bost be appointed overseer of the road in the Room of James Wanna maker, and have the same bounds and hands.

This day James Winton proved the killing of a wolf over four months old within the bounds of Grundy County, and produced the scalp of said wolf here in open court, there being five Justices present. Whereupon the court ordered the same to be certified to the Treasurer for payment and that the Sheriff burn the Scalp &c.

Ordered by the Court that Edmon Martin be appointed Overseer of the Hickory Creek Road up the Mountain in the room of Preston Fletcher or any Subsequent overseer of Said Road and that he have the same bounds and hands to worke and keep the same in repair.

Ordered by the Court that Thomas Harrison Sen'r be appointed Overseer of the road leading from Paynes Cove to Cumberland by way of Nesbetts, Solomon P. Goodman's Mill & R. C. Caldwell's from the said Nesbeth to the Said R. C. Caldwell's, and that he have the following hands (towit, William Nesbetts, and his two sons, Thomas Sanders, Jacob Sanders, William Cox, Isiah Cox, William Layne, Matison Nunley, Benj. Todd, Thomas Blair, James Simmons, Hansom Martin, Matison Mullens, J. R. Mullens, hands, Thos. I. Lovelace, Miles Harrison, Silas Leverton, Sebern Ikard, Jefferson Thompson, Benj. Jones, Shad-rao McBride, to work and keep said road in repair.

P-245 Ordered by the Court that A. C. Caldwell be appointed Overseer of the road (called the Winchester road) passing by R. C. Caldwell's house, from the said R. C.
