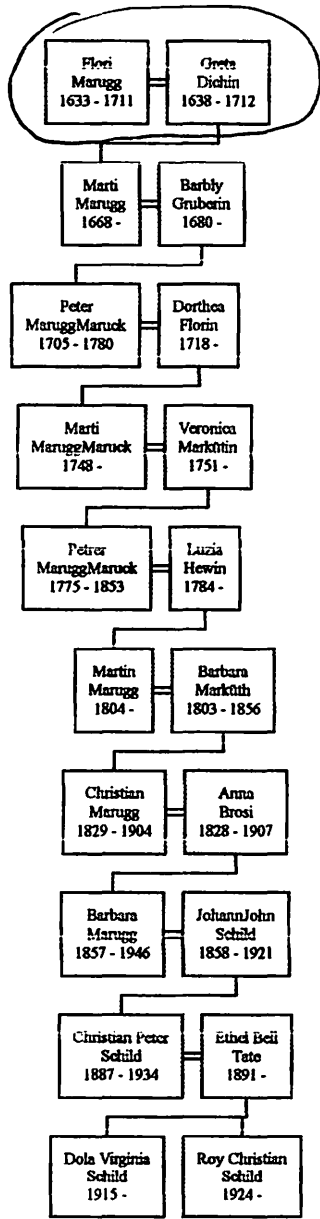

This Death record lists Lucia Maruggin age 60 years old and the wife of Hans Marugg. The Lutheran church records, LDS Film #1183592 only lists a Zia Marugg as being Christened on October 3, 1708 and no Lucia Marugg during the period of the Lutheran records, 1687 to 1715. Film #1183592 is a translation of the original church records. Thus the German for Lucia could be translated as Zia. Also Lucia is also known as Luzia in German and pronouncing Luzia in German the "Lu" is quite silent and the Priest writes Zia.

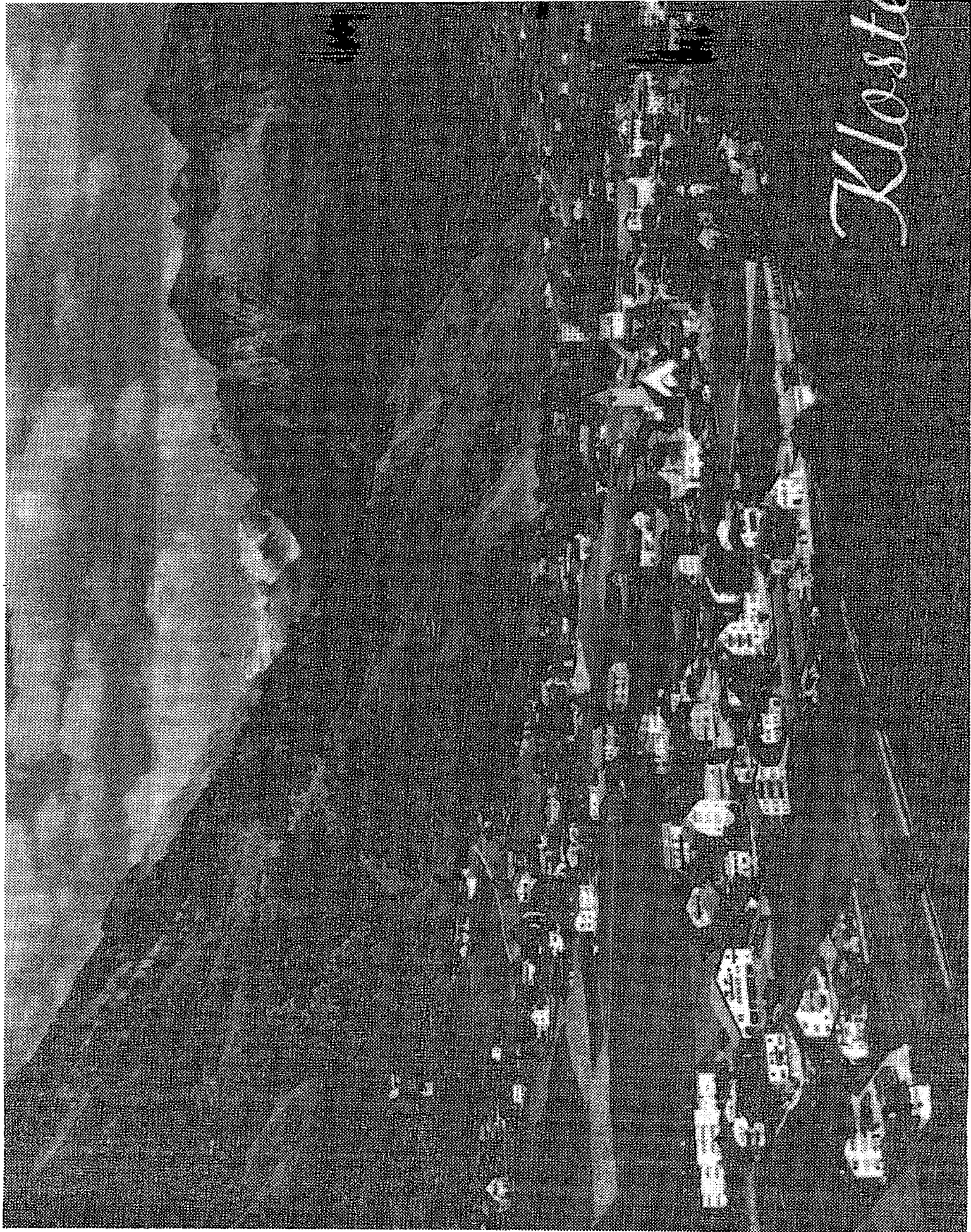

## CHRISTIAN MARUGG

Christian Marugg was born August 16, 1829 in Klosters, Graubünden Kanton (State), Switzerland. His parents were Martin Marugg and Barbara Markúth. In Switzerland, women do not change their name when they get married. Marti, Marty and Martin were favorite names for the Marugg family.

By the time he married Anna Brosi in 1856, he held a responsible position with the church. In Switzerland, the church is part of the government and had the authority to penalize individuals, control the public lands, record christenings, marriages and deaths. If you do not own land and want to own a cow, you must lease land from the church to graze the cow and to produce hay for the winter.

In 1869 word throughout Switzerland was about the Swiss Colony being established in the Cumberland Mountains of Tennessee. Christian was attracted to the idea of moving to the "New World" but his youngest child was only 2 years old and Anna was not healthy, thus his dream was delayed. However, on February 27, 1873, Christian and family arrived in New York, and continued their travel to Tennessee. Their arrival time is unknown but is expected to be later than February. Barbara Marugg Schild later related that, their first night in Gruetli/Grütli was in the storage room of a local store. The children gathered leaves in sacks to be used as a mattress to sleep on, and that Anna wanted a house as big as she had in Klosters.

Christian soon started on the building of the Stage Coach Inn, a saw mill, grist mill and farming. He became active in making wine and won prizes as far away as New Orleans for his wine. His house became the focal point for community activities especially on Saturday night for dancing to Swiss music and a Swiss card game. At some point he obtained the right to be a "way station" for the stage coach route. Thus, his house became known as the "Stage Coach Inn".

In the late 1880's, for reasons unknown Christian and Anna with their two youngest children, George and Christina, returned to Klosters. The three older children chose to remain in the USA and it appears that Christian provided them with their inheritance before leaving. Barbara and John Schild were the ideal couple to operate the Stage Coach Inn properties. Rudolph was the educator and politician and had taught school in the Colony for many years and converted it from German to English language. He was also being considered for a position on the County Court system. Martin was the business man, had attended business school in New York state, worked on the railroad, newspapers and now operating the store in Gruetli, and interested in starting a store in Tracy City. George left Klosters about 1891 and returned to Gruetli, marrying Anna Rychen and starting a printing shop in Nashville. In 1892, Christina married Henry Nett, owner of the Marugg ancestral home in Klosters.

Christian died on December 8, 1904. Martin went to Klosters and brought Anna back to live with him in Tracy City. Anna died March 2, 1907.

## **STAGE COACH INN FACILITIES**

While working on a small article on Christian Marugg, I realized that almost nothing has been written about items other than the Inn. The Stage Coach Inn had quite an array of facilities in the late 1870's. Listed below are items that I remember:

1. Water tower, well and windmill to provide running water to the kitchen, and laundry-bath room. Located on North side of Inn.
2. Garden with grape vines on the fence. These vines produced the Blue ribbon prizes at the fairs, as far as New Orleans, located West side of the Inn,
3. Butchering facility located on the stream south-west of the Inn. This facility had a small building to enclose freshly butchered meat and a deck extending over the stream for easy access to running water.
4. Weighing Scales large enough to drive a wagon or cattle on located opposite the Grain Storage Building and on the west side of Colony Road and south of the Black smith shop for shoeing draft animals.
5. Large barn for housing mules, horses, and cattle, and storing hay and feed grain for the animals.

The barn was located parallel to the road, on the East side of the Colony Road which roughly is oriented North and South. The North end was for mules and horses. South of the mules/horses area is the central area, where a wagon load of hay could be placed in the central area and a large hay fork is lowered from just below the roof and inserted into the hay and lifted (by mule power) and routed north to the mule/horse area or south to the cattle area of the loft. South of the cattle area is a covered drive thru area, which, is for delivery and distribution of grain feed to the animals. The storage area, which has a floor that is elevated to the height of a wagon bed makes easy movement of grain sacks. The loft floor of the barn is extended toward Colony Road about 3 feet which gives a protection to the farmer to move from one section to another section during rainy weather. On the East side of the barn was a long shed probably for sheep.

6. A road along the north end of the barn led to the mill pond that provided power for a saw mill and maybe the grist mill mentioned above. Along this road and only about 10 yards from the barn was a corn crib located about 3+feet above ground with metal covering on the posts to prevent rats from entering the crib.
7. Firing or Target range, used during holidays to compete for prizes such as turkeys, etc. Located south of the barn and extended south eastward across the creek to the tarket area.
8. Other smaller facilities, such as fire wood storage, buggy shed, laundry room and bath and toilet were located west of the Inn as part of the garden fence..

Christian Marugg and family, wife Anna Brosi and children, Barbara, Rudolph, Martin, George, Christian and Christina arrived in New York on the ship SILESIA on 27 February 1873. Their date of arrival in Gruetli is unknown. Barbara Marugg Schild said their first night in Gruetli was in a storage room of a store. The children were given sacks and went into the woods and filled the sacks with dry leaves. Next day they began building a bed for father and mother, which consisted of cutting four equal sections of a tree trunk standing them on end as the four corners of a bed and adding sawed planks to make the bed for the sacks of leaves.

It is believed Christian soon began work on a house for the family. My Grandmother, Barbara Marugg Schild had said her mother wanted a house as large as the one she had in Klosters, Graubünden Canton, Switzerland. It has been rumored the construction of all facilities took 5 years.

***Mr. Martin Marugg, Well-Known  
Citizen, Passes in Nevada***



Martin Marugg, one of Grundy county's best known citizens and business men, died in Las Vegas, Nevada, January 4, 1941, where he went about a year ago to regain his health. Mr. Marugg was born in Klosters, Graubunden, Switzerland, on April 14th, 1861. He came to this country in the spring of 1873, and settled in the Swiss Colony, at Gruetli, Tennessee, with his parents, Christian and Anna Marugg, who later operated a Community Store and saw and grist mill. In 1891 he moved to Tracy City and had made his home here ever since. He started a mercantile business at Tracy City in 1891, and this grew into a large department store. The corporation was dissolved about fifteen years ago. Mr. Marugg continued his manufacturing and importing business until his death. In October, 1939, he and his daughter and grandson went to Nevada for his health and remained there until his passing. The body was brought to Tracy City for burial, which took place Thursday, January 9, 1941. Besides his daughter and grandson he is survived by a sister, Mrs. Barbara Schild, of McMinnville, and a brother, George Marugg, of Nashville, Tenn.

next two years at Chattanooga, where he later on became connected with the Chattanooga "Evening Democrat," and was engaged on newspaper work. Mr. Marugg then located at Nashville, where he secured work on the German paper "Anzeiger Des Sudens," as manager for about one year. After selling his interest in the above paper he located at Gruetli, where he assisted in his father's store for a while. He then went to Birmingham, Ala., where he worked on the "Age-Herald" and from there to Montgomery, in the same state, where he worked as compositor on the "Advertiser." In October, 1888, he returned to Gruetli to take charge of the store prior to his father's return to Switzerland, and in 1891, he removed to Tracy City, where he established the New York Auction store. He has devoted his entire time to his business at this place, and has succeeded in building up an extensive and profitable trade. In 1895 he and others started a telephone line between Tracy City and Beersheba Springs, and since then they have organized the Dixie Telephone Company, of which he is manager. This company has telephone connection with many of the neighboring towns in the vicinity of Tracy City and has just completed an exchange of one hundred and ten subscribers in Tracy City. The subject of this sketch is also one of the incorporators and at present vice-president of the Grundy County Bank.

December 21, 1888, Martin Marugg was united in the holy bonds of wedlock with Miss Elizabeth Schild, a daughter of Peter Schild. She was born in the Canton of Berne, Switzerland, and came to the United States with her parents when she was but

three years of age. There has been two children born to bless this congenial union: Brosi and Elsie. Mr. Marugg has always taken an active interest in local political matters, and was a member of the Grundy county auditing committee from 1889 until 1897. Politically he affiliates with the Democratic party, and in his religious life he is a communicant of the German Reformed church. Socially he is a member of the Knights of Pythias, and has represented his lodge in the grand lodge. He also belongs to the Royal Arcanum, which he has also represented in the grand lodge, and is a member of the Swiss Relief Society of Nashville. He is active, intelligent and progressive and every enterprise that is calculated to be of benefit to the community at large receives his earnest support and encouragement.

**L**EWIS P. BREWER, a public-spirited and enterprising member of the farming community of Sequatchie county, has devoted his entire life to agriculture, in the pursuit of which he has been very fortunate, and is the proprietor of as good a farm as can be found within the limits of Sequatchie county, his home being situated near the village of Mountairy.

In tracing the history of the life of our subject, we find that he is a native of Sequatchie county, which was, at that time, a part of Marion county. He was born October 13, 1831, a son of Lewis P. and Tabitha (Shadrick) Brewer, both of whom were natives of this part of Tennessee. The father died when our subject was ten



has served as constable of the district and once served as deputy sheriff of Marion county.

Mr. Bailey was also a soldier in the Civil war, joining the Union army, September 7, 1864, and served until June 30, 1865, in the Sixth Tennessee mounted troops under Captain Hurd. He operated for a time in Tennessee, and then went to Dalton, Ga., thence to Resaca, and from there to Nashville, Tenn., but was in none of the larger battles.

**M**A RTIN MARUGG, one of the most prominent and influential citizens of Tracy City, Grundy county, Tenn., where he is successfully conducting a well regulated store. He is endowed with excellent business qualifications, a character of the highest order, and it can safely be said that there are few more energetic or wide-awake men among the younger member of the business population of Grundy county, than the gentleman whose name heads this sketch. He was born in Klosters, Switzerland, in 1861, and is a son of Christian and Anna (Brosi) Marugg, the former of whom was born in 1829, and the latter in 1828. They were married in 1856. Christian Marugg was a merchant in his native land, and was also extensively interested in agriculture in that country. Both the father and grandfather of our subject were president of the district and also held many other positions of trust and honor in their native land. Christian Marugg came to the United States in 1869, and traveled through twenty-eight states, for the purpose of finding a good location with

suitable climate, etc., and finally selected Grundy county, Tenn. He returned to his native land in the same year, and in February, 1873, he came with his family and forty others, and located at what is now known as the Swiss Colony, in Grundy county. He made that place his home until 1888, when he, his wife and two of the children returned to Switzerland, where he is engaged in looking after his landed interests. Christian Marugg and family are members of the German Reformed church. While in America he affiliated with the Democratic party. There were five children in the family, three of whom are now living, and of whom we have the following record: Barbara is the wife of John Sabild, a sketch of whom will be found on another page of this volume; Martin, of whom this article is written; George, a merchant of Jasper, Ala., who accompanied his parents when they returned to their native land, but subsequently returned to the United States; Christina was the wife of Henry Nett, and died in Switzerland; and Rudolph, deceased, of whom a sketch will be found below.

Martin Marugg attended the schools in his native land, and, after coming to the United States, attended school at Altamont. Later he supplemented this with a course in the Eastman Business College at Poughkeepsie, N. Y., which fitted him with a thorough business and elementary education. After he had finished his schooling he became assistant bookkeeper and station agent at Tracy City, for the T. C. I. & R. R. Co., a position which he held for three years. During the time that he acted in the above capacity he learned the art of telegraphy, and then spent a portion of the
