Other chatter: David Morrow consistently said he was born in South Carolina. In 1850, there is an old couple in Coffee County: John Morrow, 76, born SC; wife, Mary, 57, born SC; Francis, 20. There had to be something to bring David to Coffee County. I would suspect that this old couple, John and Mary, both born South Carolina, might be David's parents. That would be good reason to bring David to Coffee County. He also had some attachment to DeKalb County, so I looked for a possible reason for that. In 1850, DeKalb County, there are possible parents for Ellinda Young: John Young, 69, born SC; Lucy, 63, born NC; Rachel, 27. There is that state, South Carolina, as John Young's birthplace! Doesn't that sorta make your ears perk up and you wonder about the story that David Morrow was born Ireland?

There was a David Morrow in Warren County, 1820 census. DeKalb County was formed 1837 from many counties, including Warren. In 1840 there is a David Morrow, 40 to 50 years old, in DeKalb. Do you know the reason David went back to DeKalb County to die? Perhaps another child living there. Surely must have been some good reason to take him back at his age, and with so much family in Coffee County.

A few additions: Nannie H. Morrow is buried Farrar Hill Cemetery, Coffee Co. Coffee County marriage records show William J. Morrow married Mary E. Turner, 19 Dec 1873. In a couple of places, the initials for the husband of Mary Ann Morrow is given as G. D. F. Marriage date is 18 Jan 1866, by J. C. Haly. Death date in Coffee County cemetery records for Andrew Johnson Morrow is 1909. Birth date for David Franklin Morrow is 1 Jun 1865. And his marriage to Caroline Bowden is 15 Apr 1897. I don't mean to imply that this data or these dates are the correct one...its just that I noted the discrepancies. You didn't give your sources for information. What I checked are books by Coffee County Historical Society and censuses by Sistlers, of Nashville. Of course, they make mistakes just like the rest of us!
