Was known as Aunt Siby to her niece's and nephews. Was a wonderful woman and loved her grandchildren very much. When she would give them a hug she would always say to them as she hugged you "God love ya"

The following stories are things she told me a few months before she died. So they are not in any order:

Granny told me a story about Howard B. Rust tore down the old store building and while he did that they lived in a house that her brother Bill had and they did not have to pay rent. Howard saved the nails out of the store building and straighten them so he could use them in their new house he was building. The new house had lumber given to them by her brother and they hauled it for them and the house had 2 bedrooms and kitchen and dining room. This house was at the top of Sweeten Clouse Hill. When the house was built the floors were the last thing to be laid and Henry would play in the dirt under the floors. One day when he was about 5 years old Granny said she heard him screaming and she ran to see what was wrong and a snake had gotten down under there and he could not get out of there, so she lifted him up and he never went under there again.

Granny walked to school 2 miles each way at the Clouse School house and then the next year she might go to Sweeten School which was 2 miles the other direction. She only went to the eighty grade because it was to far to walk to go to high school in Tracy City. She sub at school but didn't like it to much.

She said when she was a little girl she had go to the woods to do her business. She was afraid to cross the creek to the garden by herself because it was along way she thought from the house. When she was in school which the school house at Clouse Hill was next to the cemetery. They also had to go to the woods to do their business.

The had only 2 dresses and one pair of shoes and sometimes didn't have them until Christmas. Didn't know what pants or shorts were.

Her brothers came over real often to her store and gave Henry B. candy and cokes all the time and that is why his teeth feel out. Her brothers didn't have a lot to do with Dennis and she said she didn't know why. Dennis and Henry were very differ ant growing up and are

still that way today.

The water near their house was called "Clabber Water". It had foam that developed on the top and you had to move it back to dip the water. It tasted like sulfur water and it is now covered over by the lake. Her mother sent her and one of her brothers to get water one day and they stopped to play along the way at a friends and got water there instead of where they usually get it. Her mother told them she didn't know where they got the water but it was no count.

Fa Church let Henry B. ride a log across the river. Her daddy never hurt her in any way until one day the man they got there house from came by and her daddy didn't get a deed and when this man came by she was in between her daddy's legs and when the man came by he got real ugly with her daddy and he knocked her down when he stood up to cut the man with a knife. He was not able to cut him because the man RAN. Her daddy would take her kittens and cut their ears and tails off and then he would just laugh.

Emma never did anything around the house she watched Granny do the work. Clarence was petted to death also. He left the barn door open and let the cow out. He was not made to do anything either.

Des and Granny milked 4 cows. Sometimes Des would pinch the cows and the cow would kick him. He would watch Granny until she finished.

John had a car garage and he would let Granny stay with him while he worked and some lady made him stop letting her stay cus she was afraid she would get hurt. So she had to leave.

Granny had some ducks and her daddy hated the gander so he killed it and threw it up in the barn. Her mother loved to gander and she would look everywhere and asked everyone if they had seen it. Of course they said "No". Grannies daddy had to get the gander down out of the barn because it started to smell. Her mother never knew about it.

Granny said she would snick out at night and go dancing with her brothers. They would come by after her parents were asleep on horse back. She would dance way up in the night and her parents must have known because the next morning after she would do this they would wake her extra early.
