my property both Real and personal  
of every description whatever, absolutely  
~~and~~ forever, freely to dispose of as she  
may see proper.

Item 3<sup>d</sup> I do hereby nominate and appoint  
Jm Bauldin, as Executor of this my  
last will and Testament; And desire that  
he have the power of executing the  
provisions of this will, without the neces-  
sity of giving any security, as such  
Executor whatever.
