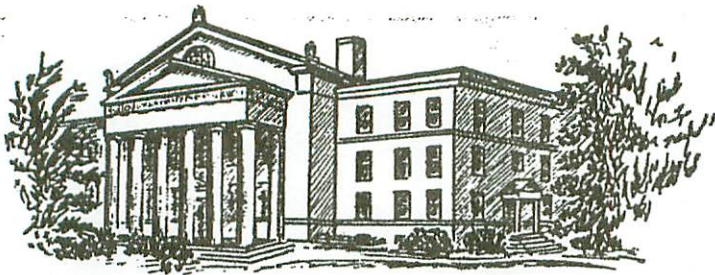

It was good to hear from you, The surprise meeting of you and Andrew with the Lawings' Amages me!! Especially that they saw a connection with the name Shrum.

I was at the Homeplace of Henry Shrum, that he lived at, to look after his mother Margaret about a month ago, With Wayne Shrum of Richmond Va. This was the Land Nicholas first received as a state Grant in 1769 while this area was Mecklenburg Co., He actually was here by 1767 for his name appears as a witness on a land Transaction bearing that date.

Henry Shrum + Sugannah Dudsons wedding on 7 Mar. 1797 Was Witnessed by JOHANN DUDROW the names are written in German. The name PUDRO OR DUDEROW was Anglicised with a (T instead of the harsher D,) and today spelled (TOTHEROW) this family intermarried with the Shrums locally and travelled to Tenn., Missouri, and were on the First Wagon Train leaving Independence Mo. for Oregon.

Henry sold the Homeplace in 1809 to Jonas Friday and went to Tennessee. There must be a very interesting contemporary History connected with the family of which you can be justly proud.

1193 SHRUM HISTORY IN GRUNDY COUNTY

The earliest Shrum listed in our area was Henry Shrum. Henry left Lincoln Co. NC, after the death of his mother in 1809. He got a land grant #982 of 100 acres in Bledsoe County, TN and was still there in the 1830 census. He had 4 sons and one daughter. Moses Shrum his son married Mary Parson in 1824 and also had a land grant in Bledsoe County, TN. By 1850 Moses had moved to Marion Co., TN. Census 1850, page 907. Moses and Mary had 2 sons and 6 daughters. His son John F. Shrum married Jane Johnson of Marion County, TN They had 8 sons and 6 daughters. John owned a lot of land, John's Ridge, and Pryor Ridge John was also in the Civil War. John and Jane are buried in Burns Cemetery in White City, TN.

John's second son Moses Shrum 9/1860 - 6/11/1922 married Sherilda Jane Simpson (12/11/1869 - 4/17/1943) in Marion County 4/13/1884. They lived in Grundy County - Clouse Hill Community.

John's sister, Martha Shrum 8/14/1828 - 6/30/1910 married Charles Foster born in England. They owned land in Marion County,

and that is where Foster Falls got its name. Their children were Francis, Mary Jane, Martha, Robert, Ellen, Sarah and Elizabeth. Charles Foster kept a diary and the last entry was 7/1865. Much has been written about this family.

Moses Shrum and Sherilda had 4 sons and 5 daughters. Minnie Shrum 4/1888 married Bill Oliver, Mary Shrum 1/1/1894 married Eldridge Burnett, Maudie Shrum 11/1895 married Tom Melton, James Shrum 5/1889 married Fosie Tate, Virgie Shrum married 1. Marion Sweeton 2 Monroe Roberts, Waldon Shrum 1904 - 8/28/1989 married 1. Cora Gibbs, 2 Mabel Nolan, Andrew Jackson Shrum 8/25/1905 - 9/13/1936 married Della Mae Gibbs, Veola Shrum 9/13/1906 - 8/16/1987 married 1. Melvin Argo, 2 Arvid Gibbs, Joe Shrum 2/18/1909 - 12/1/1988 married Grace Dishroon. Moses and Sherilda are buried at Clouse Hill Cemetery, Tracy City, TN.

Andrew Jackson Shrum married Della Mae Gibbs (1/16/1913-9/23/1979) On 6/13/1927 in Grundy Co. TN. Andrew Jackson Shrum worked at the Palmer Mine for the Consolidated Coal Company. He died young at age 31 with problems caused by coal dust. Della lived in the company house and raised four children. When the last child was grown the family moved to Hamilton Co. Chattanooga, TN.

Andrew Jackson Shrum buried by his parents at Clouse Hill Cemetery. Della Mae buried at Hamilton Memorial Gardens, Chattanooga, TN. There are still many Shrums in PA, North Carolina, Missouri, and TN. And they are all descendants of Johann Jacob and Anna Maria Shrum and their sons who came to America in 1738 from Waldmohr, Germany, and settled in York, PA. to payoff their indenture for passage. The German pronunciation for Totherow would sound similar to "Duderow" in the clipped, vowel accented, German. The pronunciation has been seen recorded as "Dudro", and also as "Tetherow".

It has been rumored that Susannah died (drowned) while crossing the Little Tennessee River. This river originates in the Great Smoky Mountains of western North Carolina, and flows generally westward through Blount and Monroe Counties, then into Loudon County, Tennessee, where it becomes part of the larger Tennessee River.

Henry Shrum sold property in Lincoln County, North Carolina in the year 1809 to Jonas Friday. It may be assumed then that he left North Carolina just after that time. Later census records for his son, Levi, indicate that Levi was born in 1810 in North Carolina, but no birth record has been found so that is not proven.

If Susannah drowned during this family's migration westward, then this too would have occurred sometime after 1809. Later census data from Missouri, for a Henry Shrum & family, indicates that whatever has happened to Susannah, Henry has remarried.
