I Polley Gote do make and publish this as my last will and testament hereby revoking and making void all other wills by me at any time made. First I direct that my funeral expenses and all my debts be paid as soon after my death as possible out of any moneys that I may die possessed of or may first come into the hands of my executor. Secondly I will and bequeath to my husband Robert Gote my boy more and cow Thirdly I will and bequeath to Spencer Saffley one shifer yearling and all the moneys due me. Fourthly I will and bequeath to Polley Hill the wife of James Hill and to Franky Saffley the wife of Spencer Saffley and Treasy Mcgregery the wife of Jason Mcgregery all of my household and kitchen furniture and lastly I do hereby in witness whereof I do to this my will set my hand and seal
