I was told to send you this check, for (1) Grundy County Heritage Book, by my older sister Dola Ivey Rector. Both of us spend our childhood in Palmer. I, Elizabeth (Becky) Ivey Teague. I went and graduated from Palmer Elementary School (1937) and Grundy County High School in 1941. Our parents lived in Tracy City a number of years, moving to Palmer 1918. I was born in Palmer – 1922. to James Ferris Ivey and Clara Ruth, Poe, Ivey. Our mother died 1937 and Daddy in 1951. We were one of the first family to move to Palmer. Daddy was a blacksmith and sharpened the augers bits and built little cars to load the coal on. Our older brothers R. B. Ivey, in later years, became –time keeper and worked in the office in town. We also had a older sister, Vaudie Ivey married Roy Barker and lived in Palmer, also.
