This 1939 Warren County Highway Map was used by the Bureau of Census to establish 1940 Census Enumeration Districts

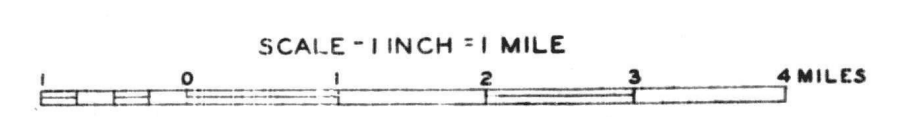
